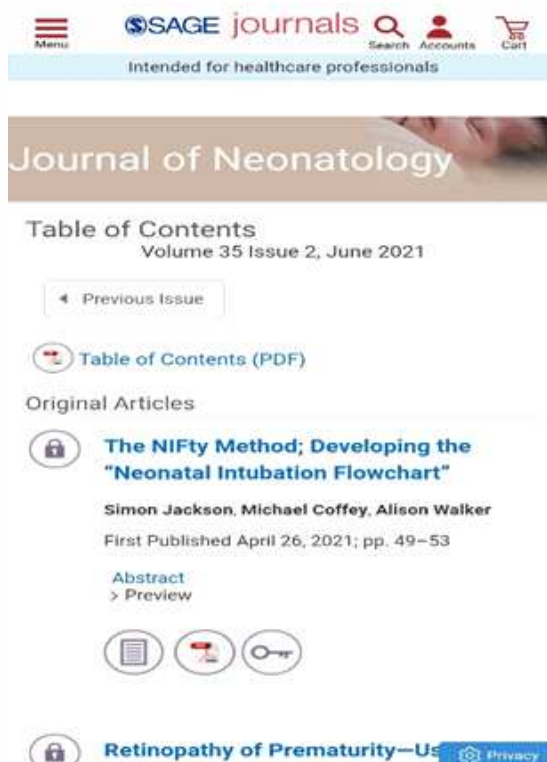

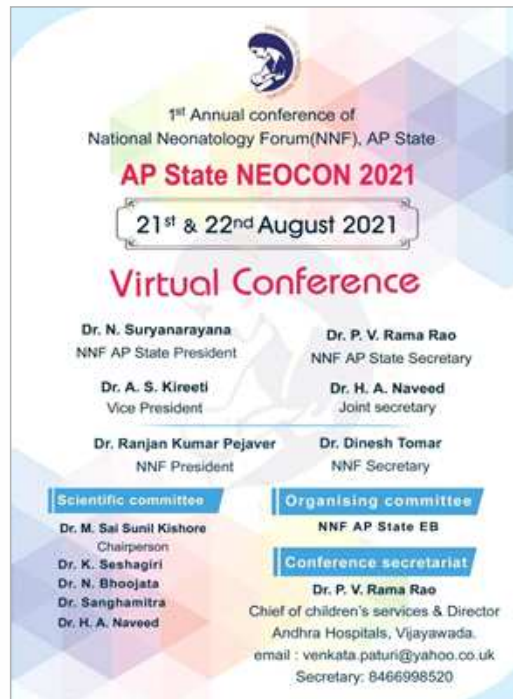

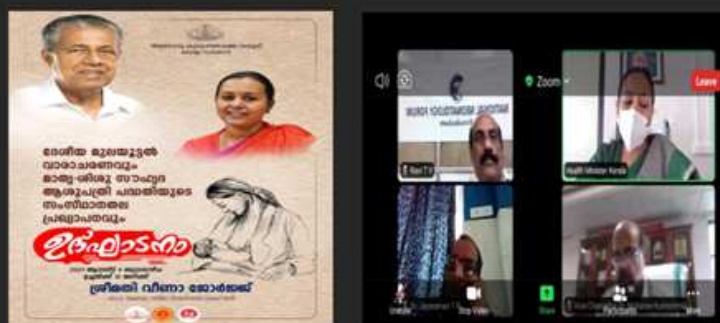
Breast feeding week inaugural function, NNF Kerala

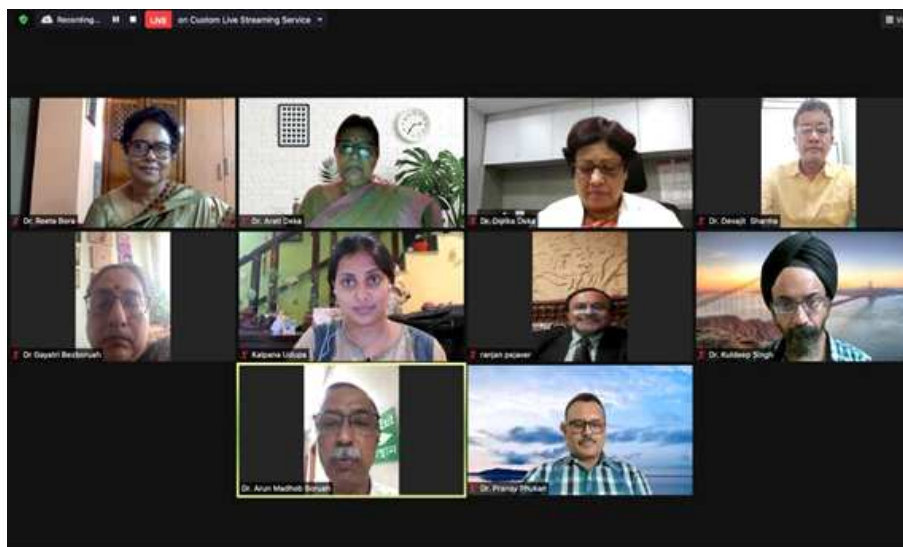

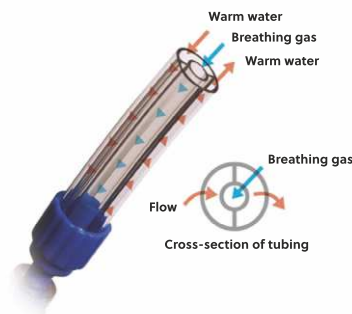

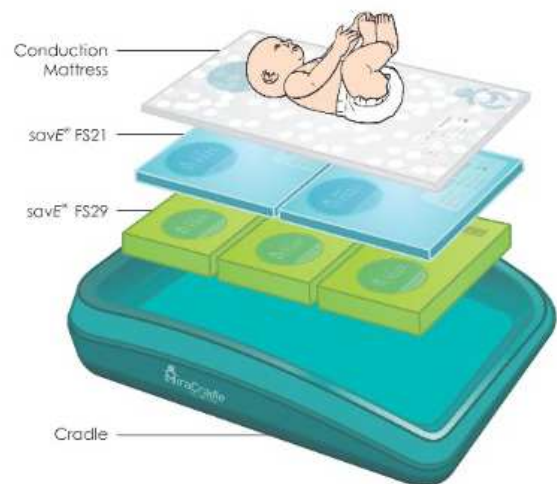
