The 2 webinars which followed were well attended by members of across NNF, IAP, FOGSI, GOI, UNICEF and WHO.


There were 2 documents prepared and released, a 73 page detailed main document and a 20 paged booklet which was produced by UNICEF.


Breast feeding week inaugural function, NNF Kerala
