

Nominations for Award of Fellowship of NNF (FNNF)-2023

A. Rules for Nomination for Fellowship of NNF:-

- The National Neonatology Forum (NNF) confers fellowship (FNNF) to the members
 of NNF India who have made outstanding multi-role contributions in the field of
 Neonatology inprofessional, policy, teaching, research, publications, and community
 areas. These contributions must have beenover and above the call of normal duty by
 virtue of the position/sheld by the nominee.
- 2. The nominee should have been a life member of the National Neonatology Forum for at least 10 completed years before the due date for submission of nomination to the NNF.
- 3. The proposer and the seconder of the nomination should also have been life members of the National Neonatology Forum for at least 10 years before proposing / seconding the name of any member for the FNNF.
- 4. Fellows of NNF and eligible Life members of NNF are entitled to nominate only ONE nomineefor FNNF in a given year. In case proposers/seconders have proposed more than one nomination, all such nominations would berejected.
- 5. The nomination should be submitted in the prescribed form duly proposed and seconded by the eligible fellows and/or life members of NNF.
- 6. The nomination should be accompanied by a duly signed consent of the nominee stating their willingness to be nominated for the Fellowship of the National NeonatologyForum.
- 7. Members currently holding any position in the executive body of central NNF are not eligible.

B. Rules for Nomination for Honorary Fellowship of NNF: -

- 1. Honorary Fellowship of NNF is conferred to persons who are not members of NNF but have made outstanding contributions to improve the status of neonatology and newborn health inIndia.
- 2. All other criteria from A.3- A.6 above are applicable for Honorary Fellowship nominations also.
